 Whilst clearing the debris from the trenches excavated in 1989, we proceeded to trench 6. The North section of which (2m) had been taken down to a floor level.

The south section had been taken down about 1 metre to (3). Whilst clearing the soil some fragments of pottery were uncovered in the SE corner.

- The base of a coarse ware painted amphora, found upside down.
- Resting next to the amphora were some fragments from the base of a red glazed plate.
- Further to the north was found a small piece of a similar glazed pottery sherd.

The soil is a hard, stony clay.

- More pieces of red glazed sherds found scattered amongst the soil. ESA.
- Small piece of dark brown glazed sherd. From the middle of the strata (3)
- In the same corner as the amphora SE fragment, neck of a bottle with dark glaze.
- More of the red glazed plate, from the same corner. SE
- To the west of where we found the amphora were found some bone fragments

6.30am Continuing work began yesterday on southern end of trench 6. The southern wall seems to be emerging as another wall. The large stones are placed ~~to be~~ vertically ~~tered~~ and not haphazardly but form a flat vertical plane. This joins the west wall at a right angle. But it does not seem to continue east of the west side of the N wall, here it is just a balk.

- More coarse ware and a few more pieces of red-glazed ware.

The west wall of 6 is continuing down

- weather - wispy white clouds, wind quite fresh but not strong.

- small bronze stick, 3cm long by 4mm wide approx. curved at one end, appears broken at the other (dj. hr)

- small pieces of bone

- at the northern edge of the south section there was a dark charcoal ~~covered~~ covered discoloration of the soil, bones found nearby. Surrounded by a lighter colored soil.

- small, 2cm sq. deposit of charcoal, towards NE corner of southern half of 6.

More bones slightly to the north. of charcoal.

- darkened soil at North end of south section. 60cm long

- We're now moved on to the next 10cm down. E-W. seems to be ash.

- 20cm N-S.

- 2cm deep.

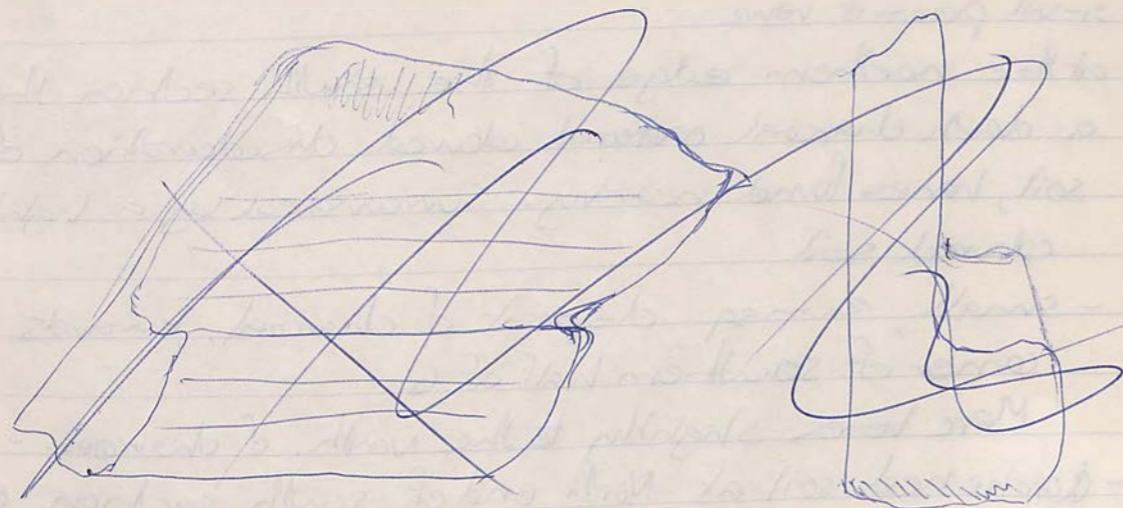

Soil in the SW corner and west side is more reddish in color.

3 sun-dried loam weights found against west wall. Surface does not seem to indicate a floor. It is very soft, earthy and loose when scraped. Found at a depth of 77cm, measured from the NE corner of the trench. (Adj Inv)

We measured the depth of the hard floor found in the northern end of trench 6. It was Int. 50cm deep as measured from the NE corner.

Decided to leave 6, suspecting floor layer where ~~there~~ wash and loam weights found but not sure.

8 am. Decided to remove balk between 5 + 6. East of east wall of store. Removing top soil first, found small piece of ancient glass at east end of balk. Removing top soil down to top of wall ^{that is} north side of balk. Then working in from south side of balk till we hit the wall.

Strata ① Soil light brown with lots of small stones and chips.

Top of wall is appearing and seems very narrow compared to the other walls. Only twice the width at the top. Lots of limestone chips in topsoil.

Fragment of architecture found in topsoil. L shaped ← see drawing. fragment of tile.

The day has turned hazy with cloud cover.

The pink zinc cream on our noses is a great source of amusement.

10.15 am At the south transept were the 5-6 walk ~~and~~ meets the east wall of the ston is a large weathered block. Part of the east wall, it runs E-W. To the north of this the rubble wall which forms the west side of G trench appears to begin

② The topsoil cleared away. It still contains lots of limestone chips and is still light brown in color. But now has more large rocks. We are moving from the ~~east~~^{south} wall of the walk between 5+6, inwards towards the wall on the south side of 6. That first seemed narrow but as more top soil was cleared more of the wall appeared to the south. Making it ~~about~~ 80-84 cm wide as seen from above. Approximately the same width as the wall between 4 and 5.

11 am. A pot is emerging in the NW corner of trench 5. It is resting tilted on its side 3/4. ~~to~~ towards the east. We are clearing the east + north walls around the pot to make its position clearer for a photograph. Photographs, bar 7, taken at 11.30 am. in situ against the ston east wall. (obj. inv.)

The curve of the body to the base is approximately level with the top of the course above the kneeling course. It is a baggy coarse ware, one handed jar. It lies approximately 33 cm above the pavement at this point.

Underneath the pot ~~there~~ were lots of limestone chips larger and more compacted than those found in the rest of the dirt in the walk.

The pot was full of windblown dirt. The rim is broken and it has a large crack running across the body. Pome wants Baksheesh!

② Part of a broken bowl was found in the NE corner of S. resting on its base. Course ware. Base complete, bowl broken. Sitting on top of flaky layers of limestone at a slightly lower level than the jug found in the NW corner. The large limestone block of the course above the levelling course ends at the NW corner where it joins the wall between S+6.

The jug carried down inside Peter's red jumper, not left to the precarious balance of Amorn's head.

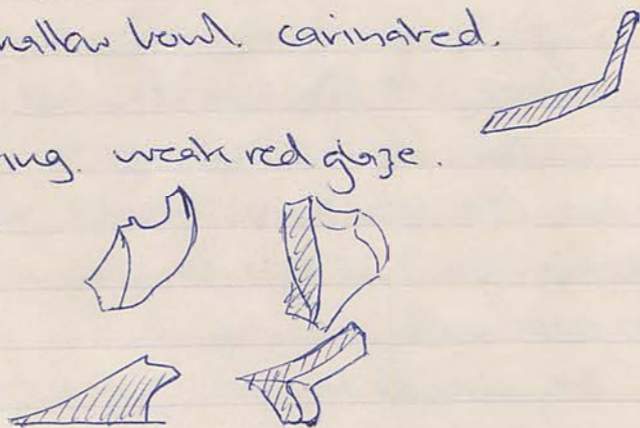

③ Continued looking for the floor in layer ③ of 392.6. Between the North walk which we removed and the rubble wall at the south end of the stoa.

Pieces of coarse ware pottery.

1 piece with signs of turning from centre of North end.

We are also removing the pile of rocks from the east side of the trenches.

Small deposit of bones from middle of northern end. And a small, canine looking tooth.

It is dusty with a light wind. Overcast and beginning to rain lightly.

A few pieces of finer looking red glazed pottery. tiny charcoal deposits. Soil is still light brown with lots of small rocks.

More bones, and another tooth.

In the middle of the trench slightly to the west was found a piece, 2cm x 2cm, painted with red + black glaze. Another small piece, 1cm sq, with black glaze.

A piece of jaw bone with a large molar still in situ. The women tell me it is a human piece. Not.

A ~~coarse~~ ^{pyramidal} object with a flat square bottom and a broken top. A hole has been drilled through the top, passing from one side to the other. Loam weight. (dj. hr.)

Under the leveling course of the east wall of the stoa there appears to be a layer of hard packed reddish dirt. Under this are more large stones.

More pottery towards the middle near the east walk. A broken toe of a pointed vessel.

The soil towards the east walk seems to contain more stones and rocks.

It is not clear if the large stones under the leveling course are rubble or masonry yet.

The course now seems to be of rubble.

I am going to measure off a 2m sq. area of the south end of the bench. from the rubble wall at the end of the stoa, extending 2 mtrs sq to the north?

9.30 Fadwa is clearing the knotted rubble from the east side of the trench. Between the east walk and the paving stones. We want to see how ^{deep} the paving stones go down.

Another paving stone, or some kind of ashlar block is appearing in the middle of trench 5 and the east walk. It now seems to be just a quite regular shaped stone.

However, lower down to the east of the paving stones has appeared another paving stone. The top of this second level is 25cm below the first. It averages about 40cm wide W-E. 55cm long N-S.

A second stone is appearing to the south. It would seem we have 2 levels of paving stones, like steps.

The second stone is the same width as the first though it is more worn on the top outside edge. ^{its surface is very crumbly.}

A large bone, perhaps from a hinc has been found between the second stone and the east walk.

A third stone to the south has now appeared. This is about 44cm wide at its northern end but is worn or broken to the south.

These lower stones are not aligned vertically with the higher level. The joints in the lower level are about 12cm to the north compared to the upper level.

The third stone ends a few centimetres further south than the last upper stone.

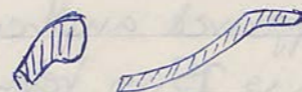

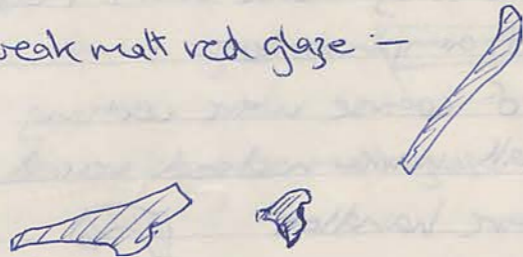

The soil here seems to be softer with not as many rocks or chips of limestone

There seems to be another stone block appearing below the second level.

Found in the area between the second level of steps and the east wall of the trench, above the third level of steps. - a small piece of pottery. Red glaze inside Black glaze outside. Decorated with at least 2 horses raised in relief and colored red. (aj. hr.)

The third layer of steps seems to ~~not~~ have its south ending at the same place as the other two. It extends from the north wall of 5 to the ending of the other steps. 2 units 41 cm ~~altogether~~, N-S.

The height of the second level step is 26 cm. Taken from the top of the third step to the highest part of the second step.

There is a hole cut into the third step. It is a rectangle. 10 cm long at its base, 5-6 cm wide, 5 cm deep. It is slightly larger, or worn, at the top edges. It is 9 cm from the edge of step 2.

The whole of step 3 does not seem to have as many joins as the first two steps

The hole is in front of the very worn middle step of the second level. And below the blocked up doorway in the east wall of the store.
