






The Archaeological site is unknown site is in the Jabal Khaleed which recognise as a Hellenistic. The excavation occurs at the Akropolis my square is no. 60, which was based with about 800 mm penit the original ground & Akropolis.

So I decide to clear between those two areas to complete the room





Walls of the room were built with lime mortar and the corners are the typical brick. The surface made from caliche was very rough and uneven with many small stones. Initial wall thickness was about 10 cm. The floor was made of hard earth with some caliche.

I start to excavate the trench nr. 60. In which appear the thickness of the wall in which the actual condition is flat ground with fine stone which indicate the wall, which rises about 100 mm above the ground. According to the grid I have 800 mm from the eastern wall which is part of the next room.



I start to excavate the area A, I cleared in first day 150 mm in which I found about 40 pieces of pottery like body sherdes and rims, also metal in nail shape as well as a few pieces of animal bones particularly birds.
