ADVICE to TRENCH SUPERVISORS

1. Take a new page for each day. (Each day may take several pages).
2. Draw a scale plan of the trench **each day** on the graph paper (essential), with North at the top (if this is not convenient, mark North direction clearly).
Mark depth from surface at the beginning of each day, at designated points.
When starting a square, this plan may be nearly empty but draw it all the same and mark in emerging tumble.
3. Draw arrows on your plan to indicate **direction** in which you are excavating.
4. Every time you designate a new context, (on the occasion of a new spit, a new feature, a new soil colour) fill in the **Context Record Sheet** for that trench, as well as describing it in your report. Store the accumulated context record sheets in the plastic sleeve in your record book.
5. **Structures** . Measure carefully any structure (wall, doorway, threshold, ovens, pit, any large dressed stones or columns) and record exact location, height, width in your report as well as on the scale plan.
6. **Floors** - marked by very hard tough surface or layer of white crushed limestone. May be softer adjacent to wall. Record thickness of floor, if we decide to dig through it.
If your floor is particularly good, collect a few bags of surface material - there may be seeds.
7. **Objects**. e.g. glass, figurine or lamp fragments, metal, stucco, loomweights, spindle whorls, beads, graffiti-ed sherds, coins, gold jewellery (some hope). Mark in the location and depth of any objects clearly and accurately. If necessary, draw another sketch plan as the day progresses. A quick sketch of the object in the report would be helpful, if it is too mysterious to name e.g. Mattie's metal blobs.
8. **Pottery:** label bags clearly in waterproof pen, with one label inside the bag and one outside. **Record daily the number of bags per context** . Be very careful to separate pottery from different contexts.
It is absolutely essential to double-bag the pottery. A broken bag of pottery without context is useless.
9. **Bone:** Collect all bone and label as for pottery. Record number of bags per context daily.
10. **Charcoal:** Collect all charcoal and label as for pottery. Record number of bags per context daily.
11. **Tile:** it is important to record the location and amount of tile.
12. **Very important:** at the completion of a trench, draw to scale:
 - i Draw a section of the exposed baulk, with details of stratigraphy clearly marked.
 - ii Draw a top plan of the completed trench, with contexts clearly marked.
 - iii Write a short summary with your interpretation of the trench.

Possible that other stones were mistaken for tumble and removed prior to discovery of pithos. Pithos wall damaged in removal but rim intact. Has notched section.
 Pot-stand removed - is intact and rather small.





2.1 Continuing to go down in c15cm spits. Exposing rocks to determine whether E-W wall continues. Overnight rain means dirt sticky - difficult to determine colour. Lots of tumble coming up. From section would expect this to stop c50cm from jebel. Some pottery, small amount of charcoal.

2.1 Cleaning top of baulk carefully to determine whether wall (which contains doorway between 64a and 64) continues. Initial thoughts are does not appear to ^{go to jebel} as animal burrows in Area D seem to go fairly deep. However could be wrong. Is clear from east face of baulk that wall at least exists on higher levels.

2.2 No ceramics or anything else came up from cleaning of baulk, so starting assault on vertical face. Taking off layer about 50cm horizontal. Wall starting to be exposed. appears to be about 70cm ~~wide~~ at the top. Will continue to c90cm deep


CONCLUSION: Fairly straightforward area. Low N/S wall seems to be primary and cut back later to be paved over with floor on which E/W wall is sitting. There is around 290mm of fill/floor material separating the two phases. Southern E/W wall (which is very poorly defined and needs a bit more work) seems to be built over N/S wall, which would appear to have been built in a continuous line at one time.

The northern E/W wall which forms a doorway into room 64 with the outside wall has an interesting indentation in the southernmost cornerstone. Was this a door post? If so, this would mean the wall is preserved to its original height, which is only c. 400mm. Maybe a socket for a gate latch? Or maybe misleading reuse of a stone with no purpose at all.

- 1.2 Unexpected feature has emerged with clearing of tumble. Small stone enclosure coming off E-W wall. Soil darker inside - sample taken. 2 bags.
 Unfortunately had been mostly excavated by time I was aware of it, so unable to change contexts inside, or at level below or outside. Juna'a assures me no pottery was found inside. Would have liked to start at 1.3 at level of top of feature, but does not appear to be any different to what's on top, so probably not a problem. Entire area only excavated to depth of 630 mm anyway.
- 2.1 New layer of small tumble in feature at 370mm. Perhaps deliberate paving/timing of floor? Some pottery coming from here.
- ⑥ Final 7657-7661

CONCLUSION - Function of stone feature unclear, but interesting that base was paved with small stones. It is sitting on a floor that paves over the E/W wall continuing through to Room 68, but cut back in a later phase. Definitely secondary. Further excavation needed to see how high jebel is here, but judging by Room 68, the floor level is very high in relation to the primary E/W wall against which the feature is built. (final plan 16a)

CONCLUSION

Were it not for limestone/adobe facing on north side, I would not recognise E/W wall as a wall. It is a very roughly made structure, and appears to have formed some sort of enclosure with the equally rough intersecting N/S wall rather than providing structural support or room division. The quality is so poor I am almost certain it would have continued to abut west wall of room 68, but was removed as not recognised during excavation. This is a good cautionary example of later structures on bedrock (possibly!).
