ADVICE to TRENCH SUPERVISORS

1. Take a **new page** for each day. (Each day may take several pages).
2. Draw a **scale plan** of the trench **each day** on the graph paper (essential), with North at the top (if this is not convenient, mark North direction clearly).
Mark depth from surface at the beginning of each day, at designated points.
When starting a square, this plan may be nearly empty but draw it all the same and mark in emerging tumble.
3. Draw arrows on your plan to indicate **direction** in which you are excavating.
4. Every time you designate a new context, (on the occasion of a new spit, a new feature, a new soil colour) fill in the **Context Record Sheet** for that trench, as well as describing it in your report. Store the accumulated context record sheets in the plastic sleeve in your record book.
5. **Structures** . Measure carefully any structure (wall, doorway, threshold, ovens, pit, any large dressed stones or columns) and record exact location, height, width in your report as well as on the scale plan.
6. **Floors** - marked by very hard tough surface or layer of white crushed limestone. May be softer adjacent to wall. Record thickness of floor, if we decide to dig through it.
If your floor is particularly good, collect a few bags of surface material - there may be seeds.
7. **Objects**. e.g. glass, figurine or lamp fragments, metal, stucco, loomweights, spindle whorls, beads, graffito-ed sherds, coins, gold jewellery (some hope). Mark in the location and depth of any objects clearly and accurately. If necessary, draw another sketch plan as the day progresses. A quick sketch of the object in the report would be helpful, if it is too mysterious to name e.g. Mattie's metal blobs.
8. **Pottery**: label bags clearly in waterproof pen, with one label inside the bag and one outside. **Record daily the number of bags per context** . Be very careful to separate pottery from different contexts.
It is absolutely essential to double-bag the pottery. A broken bag of pottery without context is useless.
9. **Bone**: Collect all bone and label as for pottery. Record number of bags per context daily.
10. **Charcoal**: Collect all charcoal and label as for pottery. Record number of bags per context daily.
11. **Tile**: it is important to record the location and amount of tile.
12. **Very important**: at the completion of a trench, draw to scale:
 - i Draw a section of the exposed baulk, with details of stratigraphy clearly marked.
 - ii Draw a top plan of the completed trench, with contexts clearly marked.
 - iii Write a short summary with your interpretation of the trench.

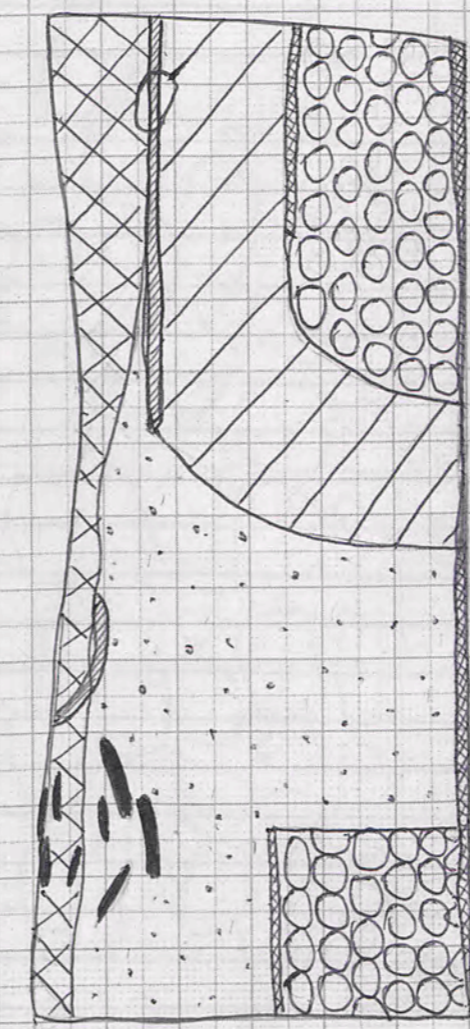

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Context Report CONCLUSION (Final plans p. 52a, 47a, 53a)

Aim of taking down Area I was to establish whether large E-W wall that was cut down in the secondary phase continued east of Room T3. Excavation confirmed that the wall was completely removed, probably at the same time as the E-W wall to the south was built to expand the area. Section shows clearly different colouring in section where wall would originally have existed, suggesting may have first been cut over and paved over with a limestone floor (like in Room T3), then removed completely later for some mysterious reason? Interesting that floor material survives on jebel under where wall would have passed - either not built directly on jebel (unlikely), or area re-floored after wall's removal. If this is the case we need to be careful about assuming jebel is always associated with primary occupation phase. Actually, forget that - if a second-phase floor was made under where wall was, then no trace of it would be visible in section. In any case, remains a mystery why floor material would be present under wall. Perhaps there are many phases of building and renovation and I am getting confused by trying to fit everything into two neat phases.

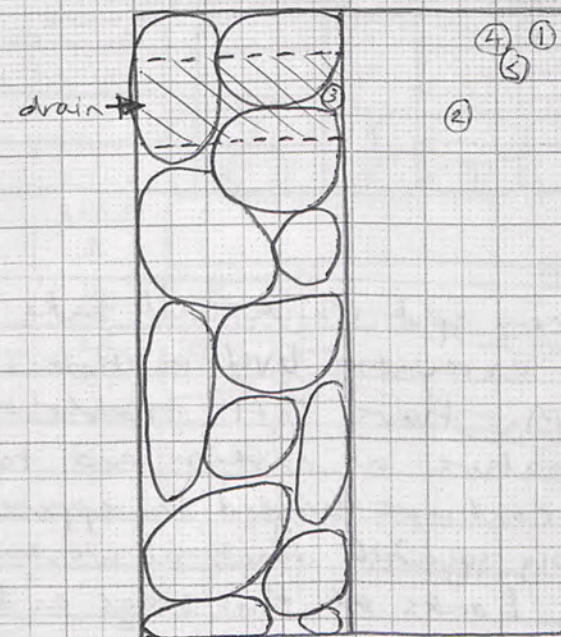

Room 61, Perimeter Wall

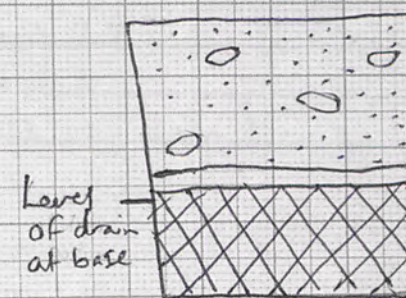

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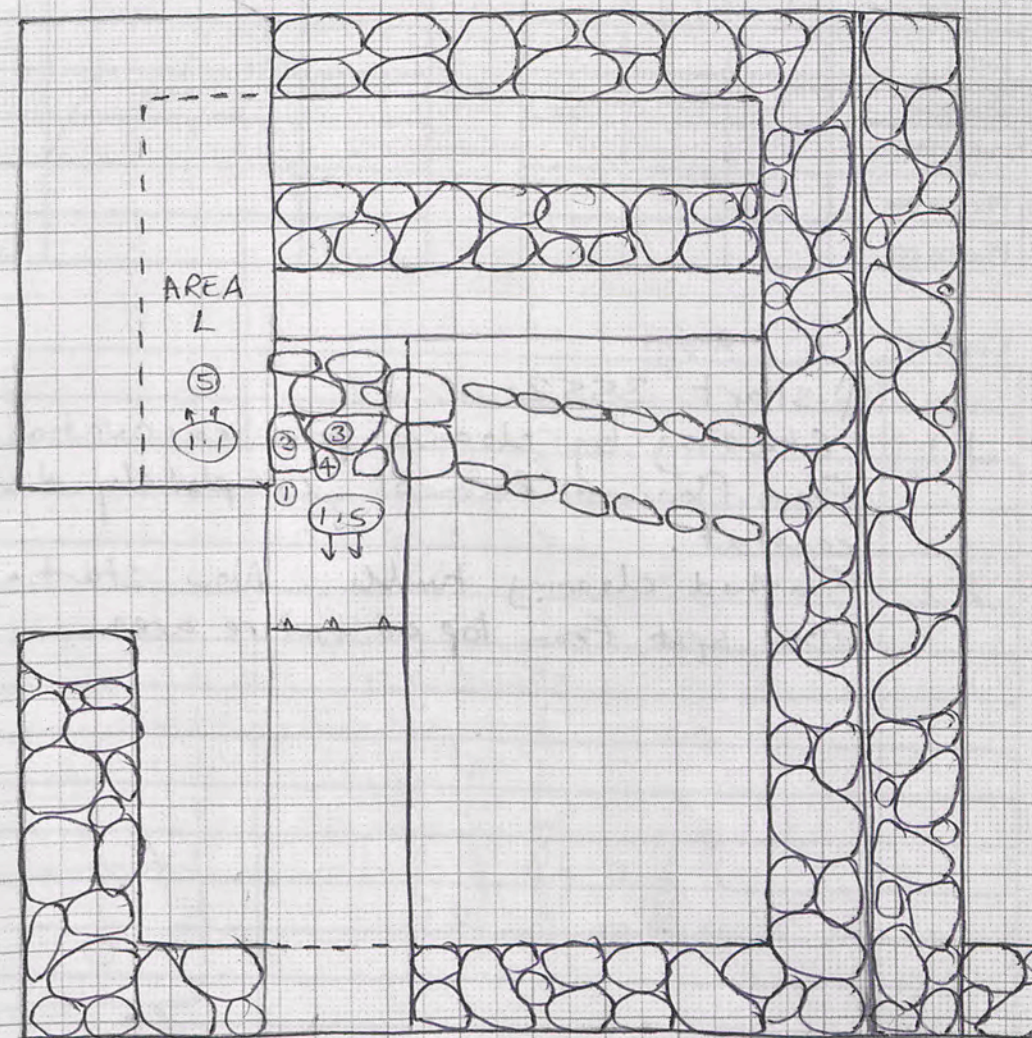

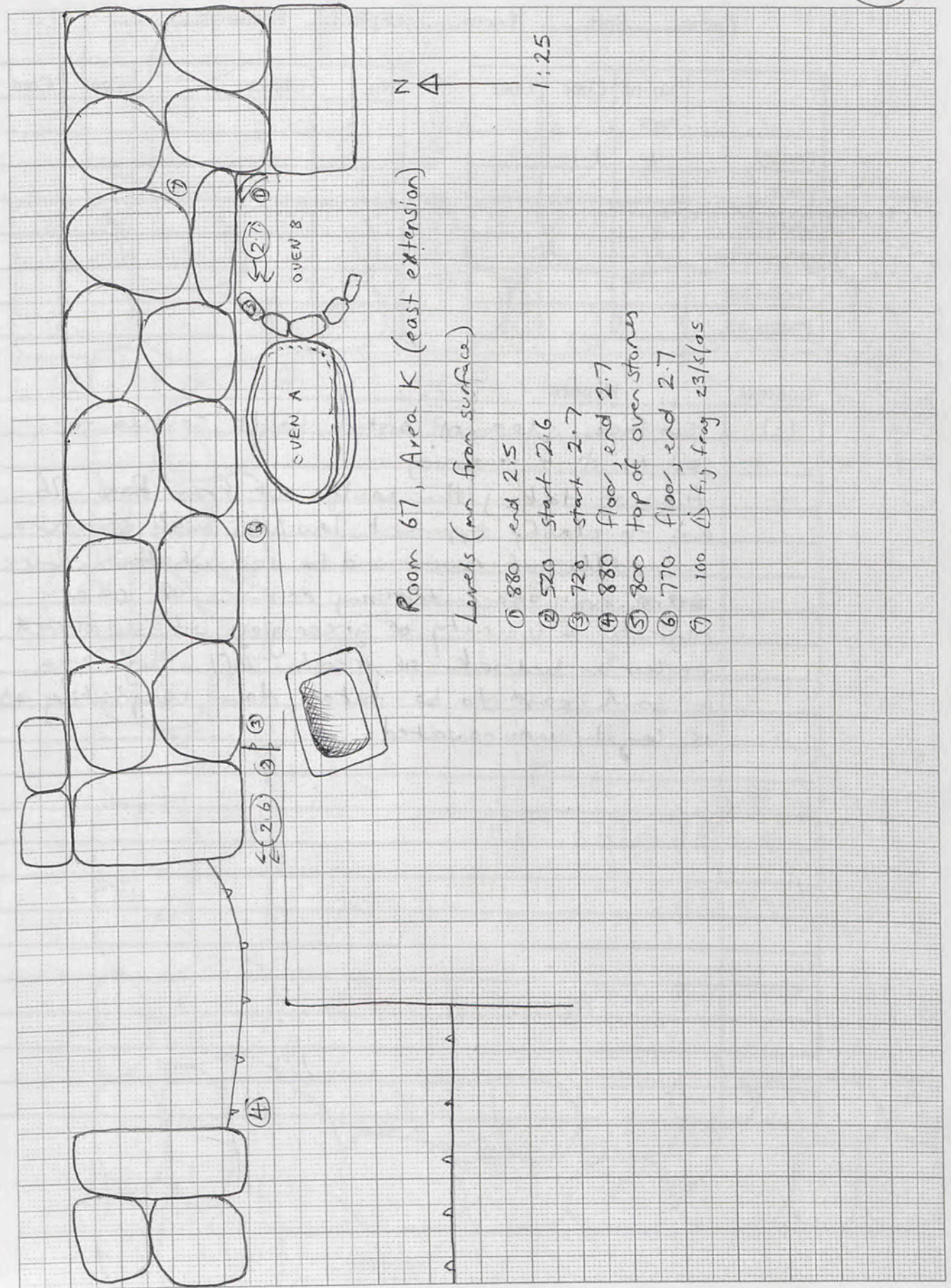

CONCLUSION (see also conclusion for Area K west on p.21). Exposed E/W wall is very poorly constructed here compared with stretch west of doorway in west extension. Interesting features include rectangular basin on floor and two adjacent ovens. Difficult to identify when ovens might have been built as Room 67 is courtyard and may have had many surface clearings even within phases. Floor with ovens is on same level as that of Room 69 to east, but lower than Room 68 in the north. This might be explained by steep gradient of jobed here. May have been a step down into courtyard. (Final plans 60a, 21a)

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Context Report Room 73 Final thoughts

See p. 65a for final plan.
 This room is exceptionally confusing. There are a number of confusing walls and floors and the ordering of things is not straightforward.
 The outer wall is inconsistent, and would appear to have been built or modified over a number of phases. Running N-S at the west of the room the wall is on jebel. This seems to be associated with the low E-W wall on jebel north of the outer room wall. However, the intersection of these walls did not form the ^{sw} corner to Room 73 only, but continues south. Further excavation would be required in Room 60 to establish whether this wall was part of an adjoining room which was modified in a later phase and cut back. Also need bedrock to north of room 73 to be certain continues on bedrock and see more clearly whether wall was built in two phases as appears from southern exposed part. In later phase inner double wall cut down, and possibly upper part of N/S wall, which was built up again later, with the addition of an unusual threshold of small stones on top of the cut down E-W wall. Lower wall seems to have had floor put over it, at which time upper part of western N/S wall built, and feature A. Cannot see how double wall could have ever functioned as drawn in this part, as N/S wall is on bedrock, and is continuous - E/W cut back wall abuts it, and thus appears to have been built later.

or at the same time. Looking east confuses the issue further (see vault drawing p 70a). To the north of the cut-back wall there is a floor which would have covered it. However, south of the wall the floor level is a course of stones lower, so there appears to have been a shallow trough at the south of the room. The secondary N/S wall at the eastern end corresponds to this, being built along the floor level on a large layer of packing to the north of the cut-back wall, but dropping a course lower to rest on the floor of the 'trough' to the south. I cannot see how the outer E/W wall could be primary in this ~~part~~^{room}, despite it resting on a level further along the insula. It does not make sense to have it resting on fill when it adjoins a N/S wall in the west that is seemingly built in the first phase with stone down to bedrock. Is it possible that it is secondary in this part, and we should not be viewing the entire stretch as a single, contemporary wall?

The evidence suggests a fairly major change between the first and second phases, although we don't have all the information we need to interpret it. I would suggest, based on floor levels, walls and architectural features that Room 73 was annexed from Room 67 in the later phase for a particular function. The mysterious 'feature A' (a long trough-like

structure with irregular inner walls) ~~suggests~~ was built when the secondary floor covers the cut-back wall, and I would suggest at the same time a layer of fill was placed to the south with a floor level just below the cut-back wall's top, and the outer wall built on this to create a closed channel or trough. The N/S wall which follows the contours of these floors was built to effect the annexation. It is difficult to speculate what the purpose of the trough and feature A might have been, but their uniqueness suggests the room may have been used in the second phase for some industrial, agrarian or other function that was not typical household activity. The creation of a trough (whatever its purpose) goes some way to explain why a seemingly great deal of effort was spent to expand the room's size only marginally. Analysis of pottery and small finds may help us understand better. It is tempting to associate the iron 'sword' with the function of feature A, against which it was found, but difficult to understand what that might be. Hopefully the soil sample from inside will prove instructive, but it was not visibly ashy, rusty, or anything special. I would love to believe the room is some sort of smithy, but there is no obvious evidence for this.

Further excavation is required to confirm that the part of the eastern N/S wall, north of the door, is secondary. If it is, as I am almost certain it should be, the upshot is that Room 67 must have been enormous in the first phase. I have concluded elsewhere that the cut-back wall was removed entirely from Room 67 based on soil colouring in the section corresponding to the wall's position further west. However, the more I think about this, the less I understand about why the soil should be differently coloured where the wall was removed: I would expect the area to be levelled if the wall was taken out, but the section clearly shows the fill that builds up the base of Room 73's 'trough', and a sharp change to brown soil where the wall was. Unless the stones were neatly dug out of the ground leaving a hole, I can't understand how this has happened. Anyway, I digress. Conclusion is that Room 73 was a purpose-built room annexed ^{from 67} for a specialized purpose after the initial phase.

FINAL THOUGHTS:

Room is comprised of walls built on jebel, which is cut down below first course of northern wall. Function of stone feature is unclear, but, if it is associated with the niche in the east wall (as suggested on p.81) then it would mean the feature was primary. Of course the association could be fortuitous. Feature walls abut room walls, so even if contemporary, we can at least say the feature was built separately from and after the main walls. Lots of pottery in this room, including two vessels (at least) inside feature. Suggests function associated with storage of household function rather than agrarian. Do not expect to complete removal of NW corner this season.

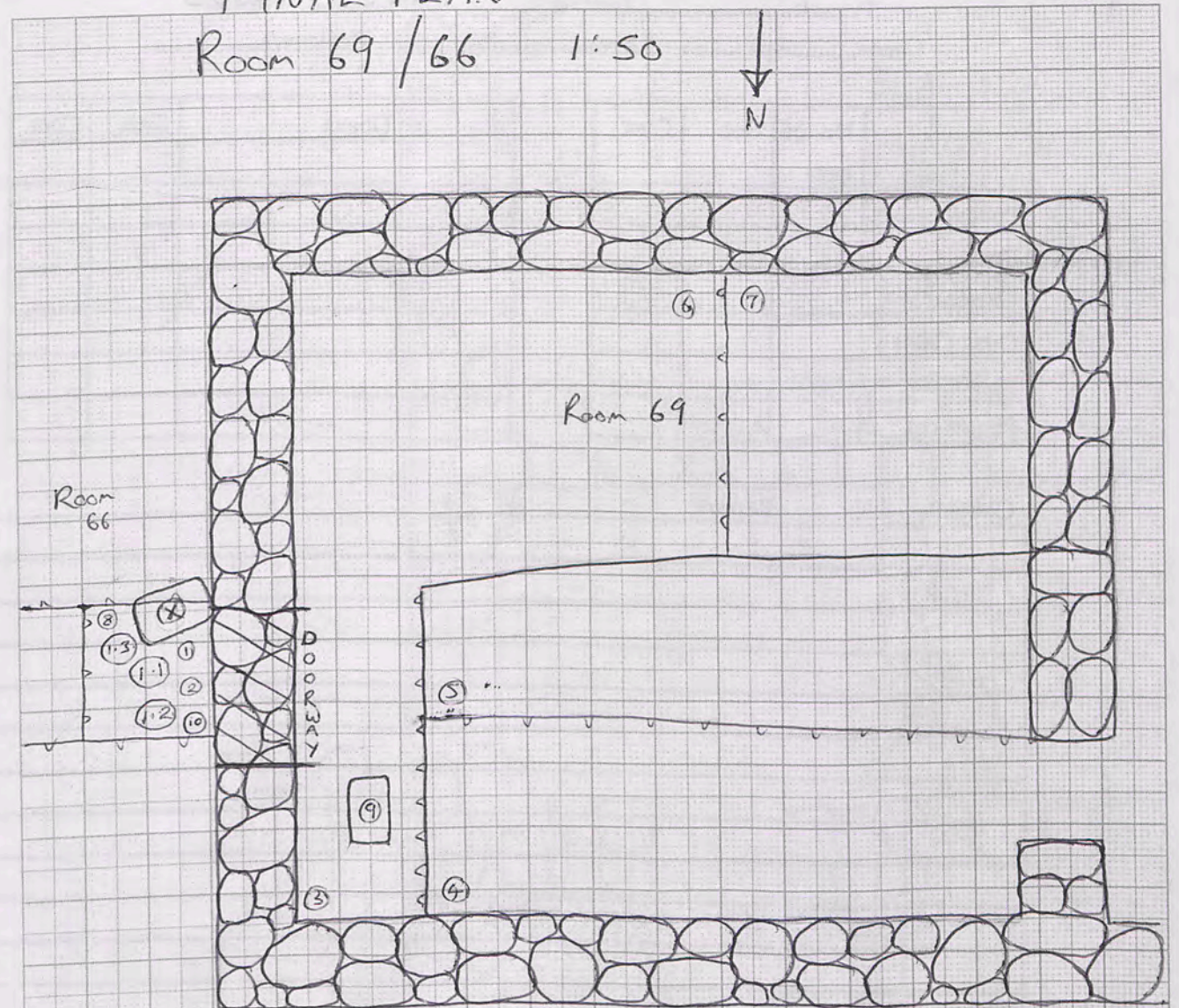

FINAL PLAN

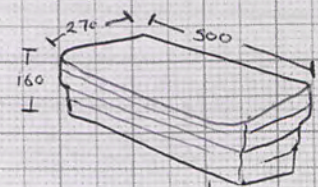

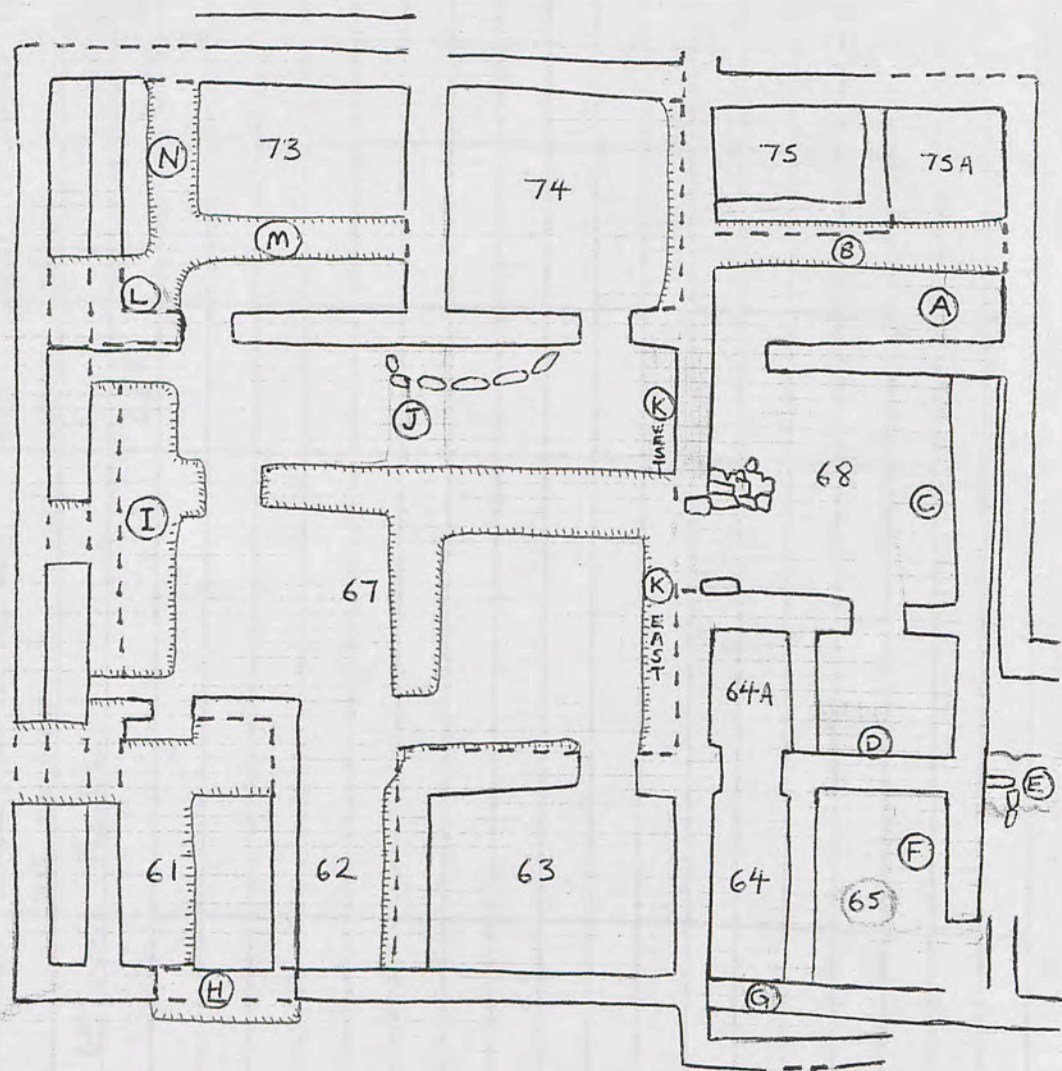

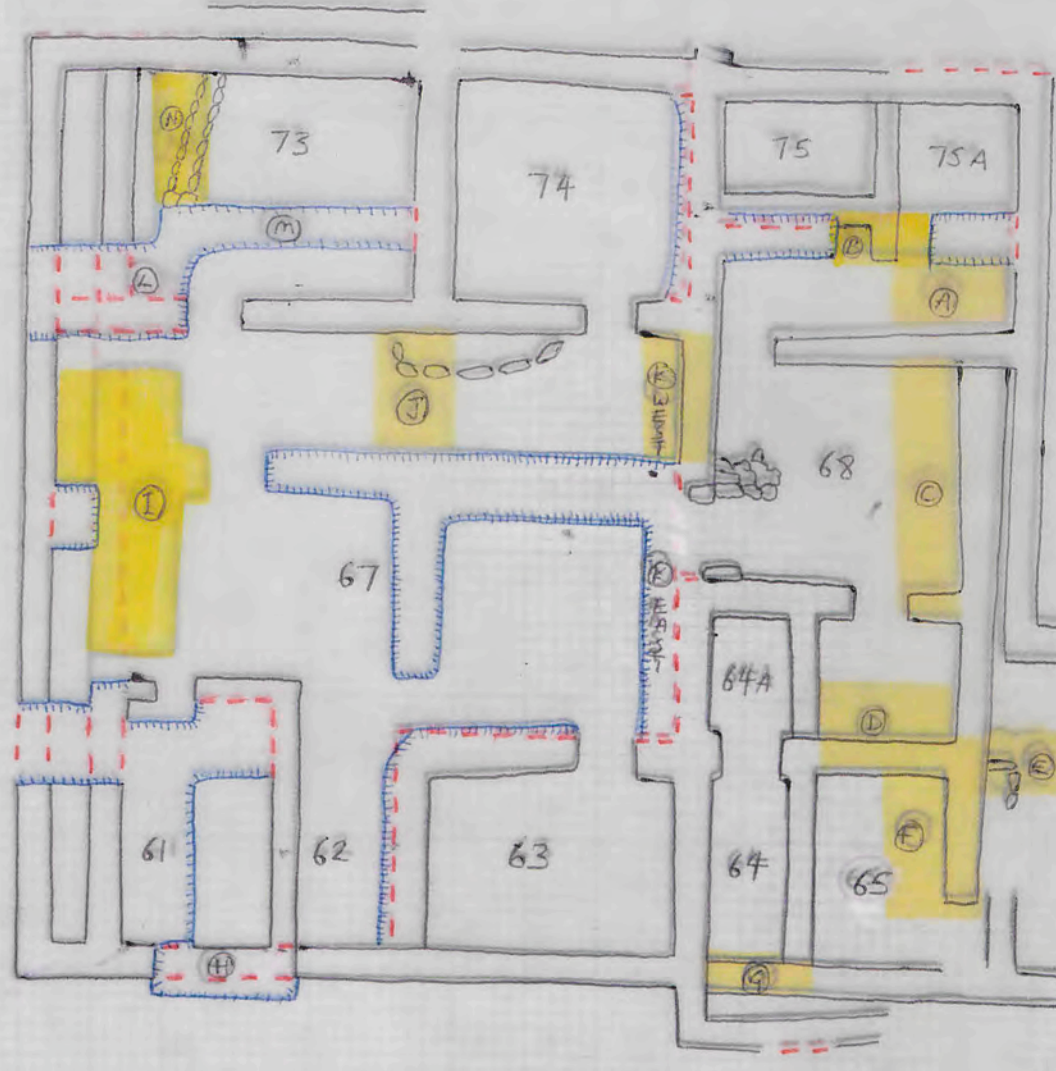
