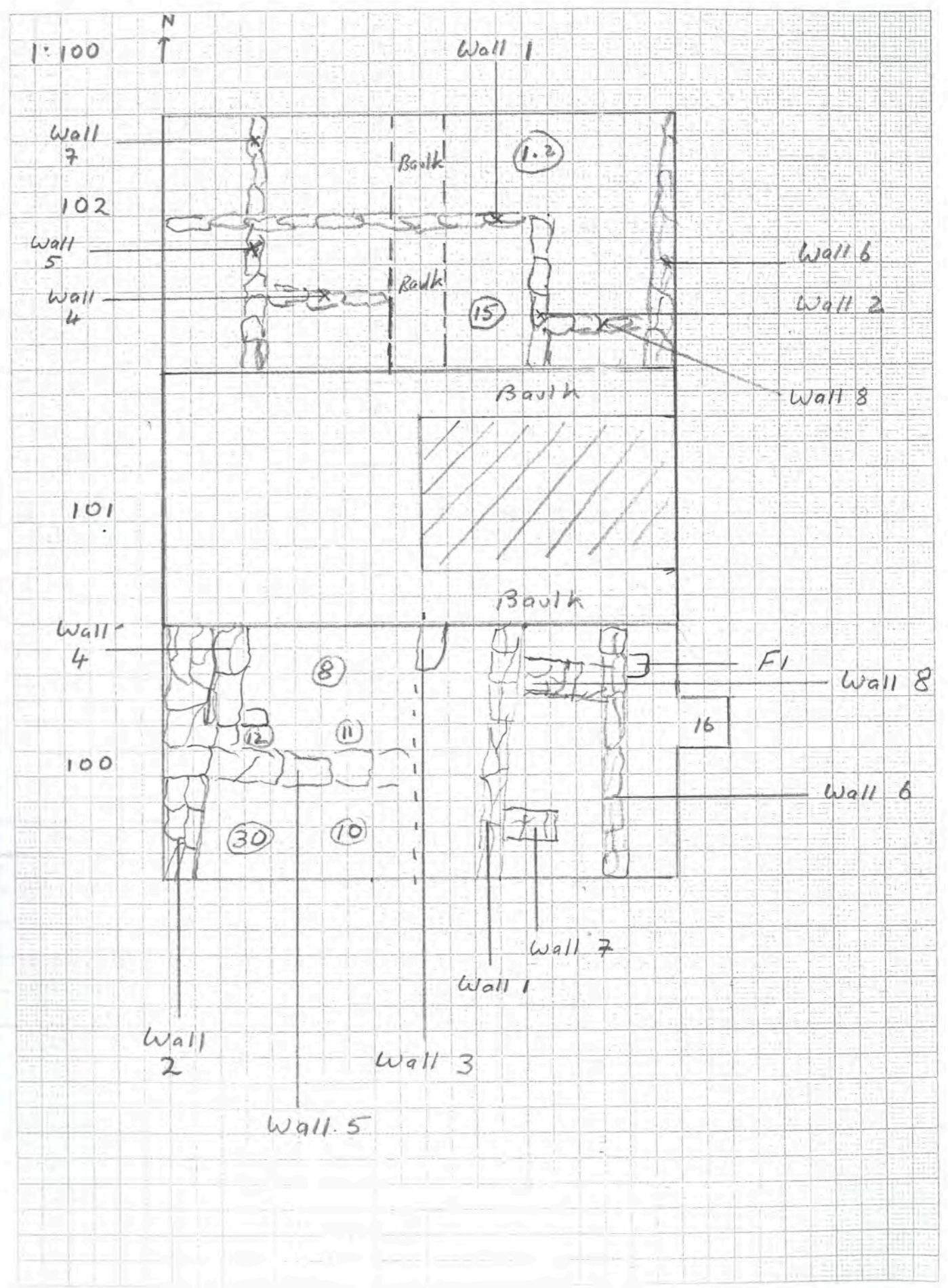

	Trench 101 was laid out along with 100 to S ^d + 102 to N ^d , in 2006 as a 5m (N-S) x 10m (E-W) trench.
	We are only digging (as yet) the E half - for W half of p 36 ff.
	A 1 metre baulk to N ^d (between Trench 102 + 101) and a 1 metre baulk to S ^d (between 100 + 101) have been left so dimensions of actual dug area are 5m (E-W) x 3m (N-S).
	The initial aim is to explore the relationship between Walls 1 & 6 in 100 and Walls 2 and 6 in 102.
