ADVICE to TRENCH SUPERVISORS


1. Take a **new page** for each day. (Each day may take several pages).
2. Draw a **scale plan** of the trench **each day** on the graph paper (essential), with North at the top (if this is not convenient, mark North direction clearly).
When starting a square, this plan may be nearly empty but draw it all the same and mark in emerging tumble. The graph paper can also be used for sketching objects etc.
3. Mark **depth** from surface at the beginning of each day, at designated points. Also record, each day, the depths taken on the sheet provided (kept in the back of your field record book)
4. Draw arrows on your plan to indicate **direction** in which you are excavating.
4. Every time you designate a new context, (on the occasion of a new spit, a new feature, a new soil colour) fill in the **Context Record Sheet** for that trench, as well as describing it in your report. Store the accumulated context record sheets in the plastic sleeve in your record book.
5. **Structures** . Measure carefully any structure (wall, doorway, threshold, ovens, pit, any large dressed stones or columns) and record exact location, height, width in your report as well as on the scale plan.
6. **Floors** - marked by very hard tough surface or layer of white crushed limestone. May be softer adjacent to wall. Record thickness of floor, if we decide to dig through it.
If your floor is particularly good, collect a few bags of surface material - there may be seeds.
7. **Objects**. e.g. glass, figurine or lamp fragments, metal, stucco, loomweights, spindle whorls, beads, graffiti-ed sherds, coins, gold jewellery (some hope). Mark in the location and depth of any objects clearly and accurately. If necessary, draw another sketch plan as the day progresses. A quick sketch of the object in the report would be helpful, if it is too mysterious to name e.g. Mattie's metal blobs.
8. **Pottery:** label bags clearly in waterproof pen, with one label inside the bag and one outside. **Record daily the number of bags per context** . Be very careful to separate pottery from different contexts.
It is absolutely essential to double-bag the pottery. A broken bag of pottery without context is useless.
9. **Bone:** Collect all bone and label as for pottery. Record number of bags per context daily.
10. **Charcoal:** Collect all charcoal and label as for pottery. Record number of bags per context daily.
11. **Tile:** it is important to record the location and amount of tile.
12. **Very important:** at the completion of a trench,
 - i DRAW (TO SCALE) a section of the exposed baulk, with details of stratigraphy clearly marked.
 - ii DRAW (TO SCALE a top plan of the completed trench, with contexts clearly marked.
 - iii WRITE a short summary with your interpretation of the trench.

1.1	Clearing all previously commenced surface to east and south of possible walls. Levels not possible as no dumpy, but surface already c5cm below point ① ^{in NE corner} . Cleaning taking down a further 5cm. Levels taken today will need to be converted when dumpy available, and level of point ④ established. Some bone, lots of pottery coming up. Soil slightly darker than surface. Pale cocoa colour. Initial impression is that N/S wall is only one course deep, but this is based on view from west, and may be different when locus 1 taken down further.
1.2	Levels taken with dumpy. Starting new spit directly under 1.1. Lots of rubble, pottery coming up. No change in soil colour. Backsight: 1.930 Restricting 1.2 to NE corner. Going down 20cm to define east face of N/S wall and to see if there is another N/S wall extending to the east, which is an extension of that in the trench to the north. Southern boundary to stop in line with E/W wall already exposed in west of trench. Does this continue?

2.1	Continuing down in area between N/S wall and possible N/S wall. Soil light brown and crumbly. Pottery coming up and bone. Hard soil emerging - possible floor. Will clear.
3.1	Separate context established east of possible N/S wall. Floor not apparent at same level as 2.1 - soil light brown crumbly. Pottery & bone. Lamp frag found at bottom of 3.1. Definitely no wall at southern end of possible N/S wall. Need to expose more to determine if there is any wall at all, or if there is a door here. E/W wall is becoming nice and clear. Glass bead found in 3.1.
3.2	Apparent that if southern part of possible N/S wall is a door, it was not deliberately blocked up. removing. Very loose packed dirt with pottery.
2.1	Hard area looks like floor level. Stops in line with door. Softer to south. After 3.2 taken down will extend context around to incorporate all of 2.1 and 3.1 except floor.
(3)	3.2 Piece of twisted wire. Too encrusted to see what kind of metal. Does not appear to be iron.





- 3.3 Taking down entire NE area of trench around eastern N/S wall, but leaving floor b/w the N/S walls. Soil light brown, crumbly with small rubble and pottery & bone. Tiny amount of charcoal in SW corner of context. Hard area emerging, apparent floor*
4.1 Removing floor in southern part of area to find jebel. Upper floor will remain in section between walls, and lower floor remains between wall and eastern baulk. Tiny piece of charcoal recovered near corner of E/W and N/S walls. Probably associated with earlier piece from 3.3. Soil colour has not changed - not associated with ash lens. Coming down on jebel not far below floor in SE corner. Jebel lower in west. Darker lens emerging against N/S wall. Will clear and remove as new spit. Greyish soil with very tiny charcoal inclusions.




- 4.1 Finishing off removal of soil above ash lens in west and jebel in east. Cleaning reveals is not in fact jebel, but rocks. New spit to surf. Pottery collected.
- 4.2 Removing ash lens and keeping soil sample. Some charcoal collected separately. Two iron frags collected from ash layer. Iron nail in ash lens. Copper alloy frag at same level as 6. Lamp frag found under level of 7. Coming down on layer of rocks at end of ash lens. Will stop here and bring area to east down to same level as end 4.2
- 4.3 Bringing down area east of ash lens as far as floor reserved along east bank. Some charcoal associated with edge of ash lens. Pottery coming up & bone. Black glaze frags found. Adjacent pieces ^{two others} found in association with piece of green glaze.



Trench 18 has yielded a complex series of floors, suggesting at least two phases of occupation. The trench is transected by central E/W and N/S walls that divide it into approximately equal quadrants. These transecting walls are associated with high floors. This is apparently due to substantial fill required on top of jebel in this area, rather than necessarily indicating a very late date. The lowest wall is (G) (see facing plan), which is built on jebel. At a later stage this appears to have been cut down to create a doorway associated with floor (F). This is too low to be associated with wall (E), but (E) is lower where it extends into T. 27. Floor (E) in the SW quadrant appears to be associated with the wall. Floor (D) seems to be associated with activity in T. 19 to the south rather than any walls in T. 18. Wall (A) is apparently built on the lower floor level in the NE quadrant, which rests on a great deal of fill. This fill may have been required to bring up floor level to previously existing floor (A) in SE quadrant. Absence of floor (D) north of wall (A) suggests occupation of the NE quadrant began later than in the SE, but ~~the floor~~ overlapped at a later point. Of course, (D) may simply be degraded in this area, as there is ~~no~~ no apparent wall or feature under wall (A) that suggests separation.



N/S wall (A) is at same floor as E/W wall (B), but is pushing in the broader context. Its abrupt cessation short of E/W wall (A) cannot be easily explained. It continues through 2 trenches to the north with greater depth and integrity. It is apparently only 2 courses deep in T. 18. Wall (H) is the highest, and the least substantial wall. It is very clearly defined from the top, and a standard c. 60cm wide, but is only a single course of stones. It is higher than the upper floor in the NE quadrant (Floor (B)), but given its proximity to the surface, it conceivably rests on a floor that has been weathered away. Floors (E) and (F) appear to be the same, with only 2cm depth separating them. However, where wall (E) seems to be sitting at the level of the floor in the SW quadrant, it is 10cm or so above the floor in the NE. This might mean the wall was constructed to transect the existing floor, and the floor east of the wall did not remain in use.



As floors (D), (E) & (F) are more or less at the same level, it could be the case that these were originally part of a large room or courtyard uninterrupted by walls.

Walls (E) may have been there from the beginning or seem to be clearly on floor in T.19 to the south, although it is still conceivable that these were built later to divide a large open space.

Ash lenses under floors in NE quadrant are probably vestiges of fires built during periods of depositing fill.



Unusual NNE/SSW tertiary wall of single course of stones may be setting on a highly degraded floor, apparent from section. Could just be repairs to floor associated with N/S wall though, as that floor slopes, and the walls appear to be on the same level.
